- Corridor/Route: A corridor or route forms a conduit between several locations that has cultural, national, historic or religious significance to the people in the surrounding areas or nation (roads, canal, rivers, trails)
- Structure: the term “structure” is used to distinguish from buildings those functional constructions made usually purposes other than creating human shelter. This also includes monuments and other structures with aesthetic qualities.
- Object: these are constructions distinguished from buildings and structures that are historical or cultural or associated specific setting or environment
- District: this is an area which possesses a significant concentration of sites, buildings, structures or objects united historically or aesthetically by plan or physical development.
